DOG BANDANA. Materials 4mm needles 30grams of chunky for the smaller size About 45gms for the bigger ones

Tension. Unimportant

Abbreviations k- knit, KFB - knit in front & back of stitch, ywfd- yarn forward

CAST ON 35TS

- 1. K1, KFB (or yfwd,) k to end
- 2. Repeat this row until 44 sts or 70 sts for med/large size

Begin decreasing by

K1, k2tog, k to end

Decrease in this way on every row until 32 sts or 54 sts for m/l Cast off.

Fold the straight edge over, you should have (1 -2" hem : enough of a hen to slip a collar through. Sew the cast off edge to the front being careful not to let the stitches show through to the front.

Add a poppy for decoration
